A few notes about registration:

- You only register <u>ONCE</u>. The email you use at registration is your <u>login</u> access for future visits and for virtual job fairs.
- Everyone who is attending must register.
- Your contact info (email, phone) is used so Government of New Brunswick staff can contact you (if you request them to do so) or to update you on any important changes. Your information will not be shared with anyone without your knowledge. There is a Privacy Policy available online if you have any questions.



A couple more things about registration:

- You can attach your LinkedIn profile if you wish, though not required
- You can attach your resume to your registration form too. Recruiters can open your resume to view it. This is not required either as you can participate without uploading your resume.
- You can personalize your profile with a photo if you wish (optional).

You will receive a confirmation screen and follow-up email once your registration is complete.







Welcome to the Virtual Job Fair.

The virtual job fair provides access to information, resources and supports to job seekers in New Brunswick.

This event is only for residents of New Brunswick and/or job-seekers who are legally entitled to work in Canada that wish to work in the province. If you live outside of Canada and do not have a work visa, permanent residency status or Canada in citizenship please visit www.welcomenb.ca for information on how to immigrate to New Brunswick.

You can text chat live with employers and other exhibitors during the event or email your questions if a booth representative is temporarily unavailable.

It is free to use this platform but you must register by using your name and a valid email address. You only have to register once and your email will act as as you login for future visits. Your email will also allow you to correspond with booth exhibitors and download any resources you wish to keep.

Before you enter the event, use the "System Check" button on the left to make sure your device is compatible. Common issues are small screen size and pop-up blockers enabled on your browser. It is Important to do a quick system check before the event to make sure your viewing device and web browser are compatible. Common issues are not disabling pop-up blockers and the screen size is too small. It is not recommended that you use a smart phone to participate in the event.

Step 3: Returning to the virtual environment / attending job fairs



Choose the job seeker section using register/login option. Enter the email you used at registration to login.



Visit www.WorkingNB.ca

Select the virtual job fair tile.



Note: If you have already registered, you don't have to do it again. You can use your email as your login for future visits to the platform or to attend virtual job fairs.



Virtual Information Platform / Job Fair Lobby



You can navigate the environment by using the event signage at the top of the screen or the navigation bar at the bottom of the screen.

You can be anywhere in the virtual environment and still be available to chat with people. IMPORTANT TIP: Turn your sound on your device as a bell will ring to notify you when you have a chat request. Your screen will also flash in the bottom right hand corner with the person's name.

At the top of the page, you can see everyone who is attending the event (Now Attending) and who is in the same location you are currently viewing (This Location). If you click on the number a drop down list will appear.

If you need help finding information or are experiencing technical difficulties, visit the help kiosk in the main lobby. The event organizer can assist you.

Information and Employer Booths

Once you enter an information or employer's booth, you can view any of the booth resources by selecting any of the labelled monitors.



Clicking on a monitor will give you access to the contents. You can watch videos, visit websites and/or download content to view later.

You will notice a green briefcase next to each item. If you click on it, that item will be saved for you and emailed it to your inbox once you leave the event.

You can also move through the entire virtual event using the navigation bar at the bottom of the screen



Communicating with booth representatives - text chat

At the top of each booth is an Info/Representative tab.



To start a chat, select the person you wish to chat with (see next page), type your message and click the "send" button.





Select a person's name to view their profile and begin a text chat.

You can converse with other job seekers and government representatives who are in the virtual environment. This is where your uploaded resume will appear (as an icon) for an employer to view. If you connected your LinkedIn profile, you will see an icon for that beside your name as well. The green chat balloon indicates the person is available for a chat. Click the icon to open the chat window.



WorkingNB

WorkingNB has many resources that you can view and download into your inbox for use later. Select the WorkingNB sign in the main lobby or the WorkingNB icon on the navigation bar.



Speak with an Employment Counsellor about your job search and career plans. Discover what Working NB can do to help you find employment.

Make sure you stop by the Resource Lounge too. There are resume templates, interviewing tips and other tools you can download for free.





JobMatchNB (optional)

JobMatchNB (powered by Magnet) is another tool you can use after the to increase your networking with employers and find job opportunities in New Brunswick. It operates much like a job board where you can post your resume, get custom job notifications and connect quickly with employers who are looking for your specific skill sets.

Check out the information in the booth and talk to the representatives if you have questions. No obligation (and it's free!). This is just a resource for you to add to your job search/career development plans.
