■ Fulfill your academic requirements

[CO-OP/Internship Program](#): Offers post-secondary students enrolled in a CO-OP or internship program hands-on experience in their field of study with federal organizations. Go to [Canada.ca](#) and search “CO-OP/Internship program”.

■ Develop research skills

[Student Employment Experience Development \(SEED\) – Summer Employment Placement](#): Provides funding to create summer job opportunities for post-secondary students. [Canada Summer Jobs \(CSJ\)](#): Provides funding to help employers create summer job opportunities for students. Funding is provided to not-for-profit organizations, public-sector employers and small businesses with 50 or fewer employees to create summer job opportunities for young people aged 15 to 30 years who are full-time students intending to return to their studies in the next school year.
